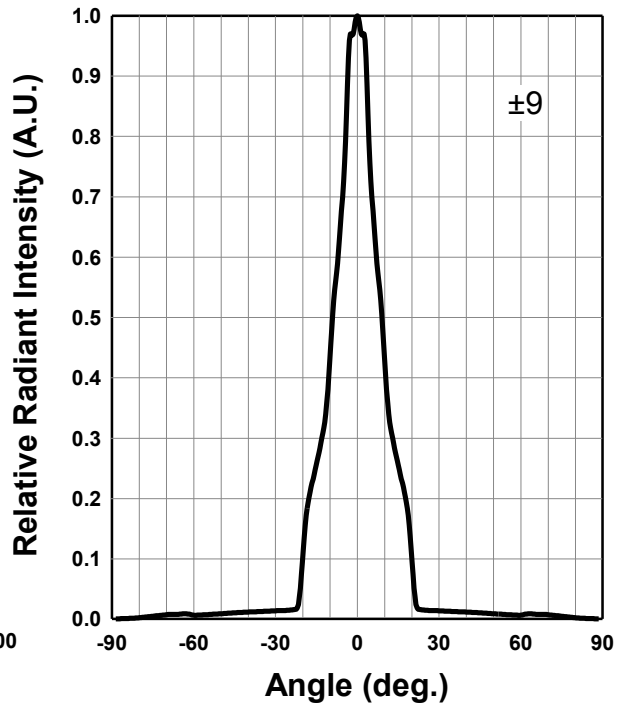




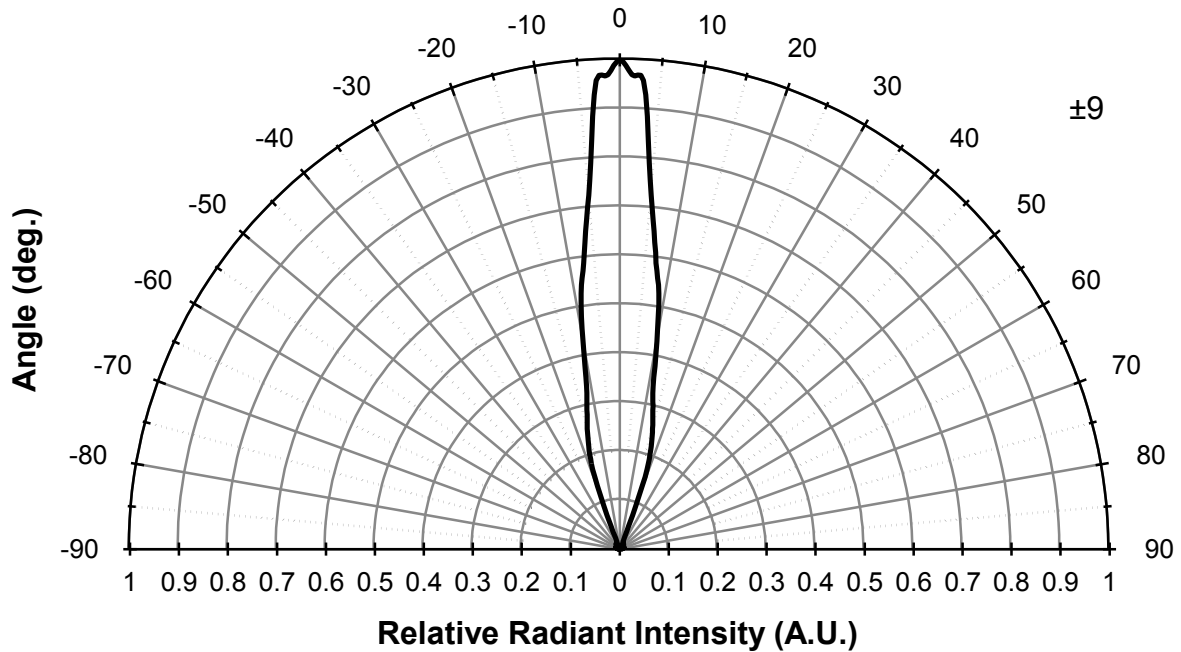
Relative Spectral Emission
